Spend the day learning the techniques and skills specific to the doll you choose to make from one of Elinor's wonderful patterns. For first timers, the dolls recommended are: The Modern Woman, The Victorian Doll, The Mermaid, or Mehitabel Dell. Most patterns cost \$10.

Purchase your pattern ahead of time. Bring your sewing machine and materials listed on the back of your pattern. It is recommended that you read the pattern through and cut out the paper pattern before class.
